

## MSC 2020 - CPD Points

### How do I get my CPD points?

MSC2020 virtual meeting is hosted on Docquity app platform.

Docquity app has an ability to track the individuals who have logged in and watched webinars in their app.

MSC 2020 CPD points will be tracked until 14th September 2020 after which, Docquity app will extract a report which will be sent to MMA for your CPD points.

Therefore, all registered attendees have until 14th September 2020 to watch the webinars before the conference ends. Also note that CPD points are for a conference, not per webinar.

A report will be generated at the end of 14th September 2020 which will be sent to MMA for CPD points.

To be eligible for CPD points, please watch at least 20 Hours of MSC 2020 between 14th August 2020 to 14th September 2020. You may watch the webinars at your own convenience and time. A notification will be sent on the Docquity mobile app to inform you on the status of your CPD points.

On another note, some Drs may have attended other virtual conferences where they have to complete quizzes or questions before they get their CPD points. As this is our first virtual conference, the organisers did not want to make it complicated, thus our attendees only have to watch the webinars.
